Raymond A. and Agnes L. Allen Memorial Scholarship

Established 1993

The Raymond A. Allen award was established by Agnes Allen in honor of her husband, Raymond A. Allen, who served as Superintendent of Schools for the Bolton Public Schools from December 3, 1973 until his death on December 31, 1982. A monetary award was presented at the annual Awards Assembly from 1983 until 2001.

In the summer of 2001, to commemorate what would have been Mr. Allen's 75th birthday, his family donated sufficient funding to endow what has now become a scholarship to be awarded annually in his memory.

Agnes Allen died November 8, 2003. She was an educator who spent many years as a teacher and also an administrator in the parochial school system. The scholarship now bears both their names and is given in their memory by their three children.

The recipient of this award must exemplify the following attributes which, as educators and parents, Mr. and Mrs. Allen felt were essential to the growth and development of young men and women:

Meritorious conduct record
Excellent character
Demonstration of school spirit
Involvement in community service
