## Hein Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was originally established to honor Richard W. Hein, a longtime resident of Bolton, having moved to town in 1977. He loved this community and believed in giving back and helping out whenever possible. He served on many committees ranging from the BHS Library Media Facility Study Committee to the Recreation Commission.

Rich especially liked working with and guiding children and young adults. Whether he was helping out with his wife's daycare, coaching youth sports, ushering or serving pancakes at church, or just being a great friend and loving father, Rich was always available. Richard W. Hein died December 30, 2002.

In addition, this scholarship now also honors the lives of Richard E. Hein and Frances G. Hein who died in 2012 and 2013 respectively. Although they were not residents of Bolton, they enjoyed visiting Bolton to watch their family grow. They attended many school and sporting events and were strong supporters of the Bolton Bulldogs from afar. Both were strong proponents of education, especially mathematics and science.
