Lois Hills was a long time resident of Bolton and a valued member of the Bolton School System. She began working at Bolton High School as secretary to the Guidance Counselor and advanced to become Executive Secretary to the Principal. She was liked and respected by all of the staff and students. She and her husband, Howard, moved to Melbourne, Florida. Lois died March 2, 2009.

Karen Hills graduated with honors in 1969 and was a member of the Bolton High School National Honor Society. She was intelligent and very talented. She played the French horn in the band and was a member of the chorus as well. She also played the guitar and participated in many talent shows throughout her high school years.

When this scholarship was established in October 1995, Kevin's parents asked that it be awarded annually to a graduating senior who loves the game as much as Kevin did, and who will carry that love for basketball with him/her after leaving Bolton High School.
